



Grandpa's Rock Cakes

Ingredients

60g butter
1/2 cup sugar
2 cups SR flour
1/2 tsp cinnamon
1 tsp ginger
1/2 tsp mixed spice



1/2 cup milk



Method

Cream butter, sugar
Add egg
Sift flour, add spices to flour
Add fruit and milk
Mix and flatten mixture with spoon dipped in milk
Leave in fridge for 15 mins
Bake 180 degrees for approx. 15 - 20mins
